Sınavınız dört temel beceri ve iki alt beceriyi ölçmektedir.

Toplam puan ağırlığı şu şekildedir:

- Main Paper (Listening, Reading, Use of English): %40
- Writing: %30
- Speaking: %30

10 Eylül’de yapılacak yazılı sınav, sırasıyla *Dinleme, Okuma, Gramer ve Kelime bilgisi ve Yazma* bölümlerinden oluşmaktadır. Bu sınavda, dinleme için bir not kağıdı, 80 çoktan seçmeli soru ve bir yazma kağıdı yer almaktadır.

Yazılı Sınav Detayları (10 Eylül, Anafartalar ve Merkez Kampüs)

Dinleme

Sınavda toplam 3 adet audio dinleyeceksiniz: 1 *note-taking* ve 2 *while-listening*. Tüm kayıtlar iki kez oynatılacaktır.

- *Note-taking* bölümünde, size verilen kağıda dinleme sırasında not alacaksınız. Bu aşamada sorular verilmeyecektir.
- Dinleme tamamlandıktan sonra ana sınav kağıdı dağıtılacak ve notlarınıza bakarak ilgili soruları cevaplamanız için süre verilecektir.
- Ardından *while-listening* bölümlerine geçilecektir. Bu kısımlarda soruları dinleme sırasında cevaplamanız beklenmektedir. Sorulara önceden göz atmanız için süre tanınacaktır.

Soru türleri:

Comprehension, listening for gist, listening for details, listening for inference

Okuma

Bu bölüm 3–4 okuma parçasına dayalı çoktan seçmeli sorulardan oluşmaktadır.

Soru türleri:

Comprehension, reading for gist, reading for details, vocabulary in context, reference ve inference

İngilizce Kullanımı

Bu bölüm, B2 seviyesindeki *grammar* ve *vocabulary* konularını kapsamaktadır. Yaklaşık 20’şer çoktan seçmeli soru içermektedir. Ayrıca her iki bölüm için birer *cloze test* bulunmaktadır.

Yazma

Size verilecek iki konudan birini seçerek, 1 giriş, en az 2 gelişme ve 1 sonuç paragrafından oluşan anlam bütünlüğü olan bir essay yazmanız beklenmektedir.

Konuşma Sınavı Detayları (11 Eylül-Merkez Kampüs B blok)

Speaking sınavında size iki farklı konu verilecektir. Bu konulardan birini seçerek, verilen hazırlık süresinde (size not kağıdı verilecektir) konuşmanızı planlamanız ve ardından belirlenen sürede sunmanız beklenmektedir. Bu sınavda temel sunum becerileri (göz teması, vücut dili vb.) beklenmektedir.
